### Summary:

The Clean India Campaign aimed to create awareness about cleanliness among citizens and students while focusing on cleaning public places and collecting plastic waste. The Clean India Campaign, organized by Pravara Rural College of Architecture (PRCA), Loni, took place from 1st to 31st October 2022. The campaign was initiated by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, to promote cleanliness and hygiene in public spaces.

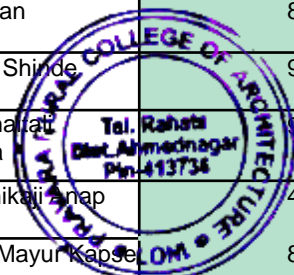
### Summary :
