#### Title:

Design Cell

#### Objectives:

- 1. To establish a professional architectural consultancy practice, run by teaching faculty as well as students.
- 2. To make commercial use of the pool of professionals gathered for the purpose of teaching, generate revenue for college as well as for the contributing faculty.



3. To expose students to the real-life architectural projects, while completing their course.

#### Context:

Our collage's mother institute Pravara Rural Education Society, has a very big infrastructure. The society operates 11 technical colleges, 6 senior colleges, 6 English medium schools including a Sainik School and 32 Marathi medium schools. In all, over 40,000 students are presently on the rolls of these institutions. The physical infrastructure of the society is continuously undergoing addition and alteration construction. And this requires a lot of architectural consultancy service. To organize the architectural service given to the society by our college, we established this professional body called Design Cell which can generate revenue for the college and at the same time generated reliable architectural service for the society. Subsequently, we were also able to generate architectural jobs of other organizations/ clients in the vicinity.

This establishment of Design Cell also created a good platform of practical learning for the students.

#### **Practice:**

This Design Cell, also known as **Pravara Design Consultancy Cell** operated on **A Project Architect** basis. Though the college principal is the principal architect of the project, the main responsibility of every assignment lies with one single architect teaching faculty, who is termed as Project Architect for that particular assignment/ project. Though the drawings and documentation work are distributed among all the teaching architects as well as students, the Authorised Representative (A.R.) is always one architect and he is supposed look after the professional communication with the patron client.

The principal of the college is the Head of the Design Cell and controls the appointments of project architects and distribution of responsibilities among other architects and students.

The students are a key component of this design cell. A team of students is selected and associated for one single project. This team is involved in the progress of this project, along with the project architect, right from the stage of brief taking from the client. The primary design is finalised by the project architect along with associate architect, in the presence of the student team associated with the project. The generation of design ideas are thoroughly discussed with the associated student team by the architects. Although this is an extra-curricular activity for the students, many a times, students do use these activities as their audit courses or electives. Other than primary commercial purpose of this Design Cell, the majority of the design development and site supervision process is necessarily student centric and contributing a lot towards students' overall development. For a student of architecture apart from learning college courses about design, technology and humanities, it is very important to get exposed to real life situations on site and get used to real life expectations of a client. Students are compulsorily involved in the client meeting for taking the design briefs. At times they are told to handle these meetings without the architect teacher, if it is manageable.

#### **Evidence of Success:**

The following table is showing the volume of work generated under Design Cell. The renumerations received against the work was 1) either free of charge as a social service under our rural connect mission or 2) it was an in-house design for our mother institute Pravara Rural Education Society, which saved a huge outgoing expenditure of the society or, 3) it was chargeable and we received fees which was divided among the society, the college and a part went to the designing faculty.

#### **Problems Encountered:**

The students worked on the Design Cell projects, outside of their curricular framework. They were able to find time outside their college hours. A part of these project works was designated under audit course which is a mandatory requirement of the university framed syllabus requirements. But because the university has very stringent framework of audit courses it become difficult to accommodate this work under syllabus.

Most of our teaching faculties are practicing architects and at times, it becomes challenging for them to spare time for design cell activities, other than college hours.

This difficulty is usually resolved by the teamwork of faculty and students, by sharing work in a team and an efficient re-distribution of work among the team.



Also, many a times the site visit hours used to clash with the college class hours and it became difficult to visit site when it is most necessary there. In resolving this problem, internet was of great help and many of the site issues could be resolved using virtual communication like drawing and image sharing or video calls.

Also at times, college infrastructure like computers, printers, etc., was not readily available as it was to be prioritised for the course activities. This difficulty was later resolved later when new purchases of infrastructure were done by the college.

As usual, students actively participated in this initiative.









## Interior of Director's office at Agri. College at Loni

The project could not have been possible without the active participation of the students.









No need to say, our students have actively participated in this initiative.






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



INTERIOR LAYOUT OF THE PHARMACEUTICS LAB




INTERIOR LAYOUT OF THE PHARMACOLOGY LAB



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



# **BEST PRACTICE NO. 2**



## 1. Title of the Practice

"Green Traditions: Nurturing Sustainability Through Innovative Celebration of Ganesh Festivals"

## 2. Objectives of the Practice

- The primary objective is to raise awareness and promote sustainable practices within the campus community and beyond.
- The celebration serves as a platform for students to showcase their creativity and apply design thinking principles.
- The festival focus on sustainability, reinforcing the importance of responsibility for environmental conservation among students, faculty, and society.
- Creation of Eco-friendly Ganesh idol through workshops and its distribution among non-teaching staff and in the society. The festival aims to extend its impact beyond the campus.

#### 3. The Context

The institute celebrates Ganesh festival based on the theme "Green Traditions: Nurturing Sustainability Through Innovative Celebration of Ganesh Festivals" which focuses on creativity with sustainability. Institute host Eco-friendly workshops, to create eco- friendly Ganesh idols for students, staff and outsiders. One of the Ganesh Idol created by Students is for establishment idol in Institute's Ganesh festival and others are distributed among staff and outsiders for their celebration at home. Students uses recycled materials for the decoration.

The college's curriculum emphasizes environmental practices, fostering design thinking and showcasing its dedication to a greener future.

# 4. The Practice

The college celebrates the Ganesh festival in the campus with a focus on sustainability through the "Best out of Waste" theme. Students create pendal using recycled materials, demonstrating the institution's commitment to environmental conservation. This tradition has been upheld for the past five years, promoting eco-consciousness within the campus community.

To expand the reach of sustainable practices, the institute hosts an Eco-friendly Ganesh idol-making workshop using Shadu maati (Natural soil). This workshop is organised not only for the students of Pravara Rural College of Architecture but also to outsiders, encouraging sustainable practices beyond the campus. Participants design Ganesh idols for their homes and the college festival, extending the ethos of sustainability. An innovative aspect of the celebration involves hostel students' crafting Eco-friendly Ganesh idols, which they distribute to college staff and outsiders.

In previous years, students designed decorations using recycled materials based on "Best out of Waste" theme by using materials such as, planks from a new photocopier box and old bamboo baskets, painted with natural and poster colours, paper craft decoration backdrop using old folio cover, in some decoration's students used thatched roof. This celebration nurtures design thinking, creativity, and collaboration among students. Designing and finalizing decoration backdrops under the guidance of a teacher coordinator helps students refine their design thinking and taking sustainability into account. This initiative reflects the college's dedication to its motto of promoting sustainable practices through the celebration of the Ganesh festival both in the campus and beyond.

# 5. Evidence of Success

The success of these events is evidenced by significant participation numbers off outside participants. In 2018-19, 10 outsiders joined a workshop, and in 2022-23, the count increased to 27, as they enthusiastically crafted Ganesh idols for their homes. These initiatives collectively engaged 37 external participants and 119 (in 2018 and 2022) number of students and staff participants, effectively promoting eco-consciousness beyond the campus with the help of these 156 numbers of participants (considering both workshops). An interesting observation is that among the 10 no. of outsider participants of the initial workshop, 8 attended the subsequent workshop as well. This pattern indicates a successful redirection of participants towards sustainable practices, highlighting our commitment. This accomplishment aligns with the college's mission, reflecting the event's impact and success in fostering sustainability within the community. The impact of these workshops extends further by enhancing students design skills, directly benefiting their academic pursuits. By engaging in creative processes and sustainable design, students develop valuable insights applicable to their studies.

# 6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required

The campus-wide Ganesh festival, themed "Best out of Waste," poses logistical hurdles. Students encounter challenges in concept development, design, material selection, sourcing, and installation. Collaborative efforts by faculty members help surmount these obstacles, ensuring the successful execution of an event that empowers students to navigate complexities with creativity and determination.

Additionally, to arrange the workshop for students, staff and society which promote our college Ganesh festival theme, it's a big challenge for the institute due to the widespread availability of acrylic and oil-based colours attractive POP idols, hindering the promotion of Eco-friendly alternatives. Promoting participation in our sustainable workshops is a challenging endeavor. Raising awareness and attracting external participants requires dedicated efforts from both students and staff members.


